From *Paradox Game Series* and *Sisyphus* to *Overture* in Ireland, his shows always use rough and raw material to create a primitive effect, and use a humorous tone to reveal the paradoxes in the mankind history. After many years of thinking on this subject, Zhang would like to turn his long-time practicing to an improvisational project for this show. We do not know what the final work will be. As the audience will see his whole work in the closing party, the work itself will be shoveled off as its final destiny. This act is a paradox for us.
